Thank you for your interest in participating in the Southeastern Art Show and Market (SEASAM) youth competition. Please read the youth entry and competition rules and provide the following requirements:

- Completed application form.
- Completed W-9 form.
- Four examples of your work in the following formats: digital images on disc, digital images on a thumb drive or digital images submitted via email to ArtistInfo@Chickasaw.net.
- Biography describing yourself, your artwork, awards, shows, education, etc.
- Proof of First American citizenship with a federally recognized Southeastern Indian tribe.
- Artwork finished and ready to hang and/or display.
- Competition pieces must be priced for sale in the market.
- Must sign photograph and release form.

2024 SEASAM Youth Requirements

1. Youth artists must present documentation of citizenship/membership in a federally recognized Southeastern Indian tribe.
2. Entries for judging will be accepted beginning Tuesday, September 3, 2024 at 8:30 a.m. CST through Friday, September 20, 2024 at 4:30 p.m. CST, at 201 North Broadway, Ada, Oklahoma 74820. Entries will not be accepted after the official judging begins.
3. To be eligible for awards, youth artists must be enrolled in a public, private or home-schooled high school and be 14 to 17 years old as of September 1, 2024.
4. The youth artist, family member or friend may enter the youth artist's work for judging. The application must be filled out in full with a letter of release signed by the person entering the artwork.
5. Entries for the judging are limited to four items with a maximum of two entries in any one category.
6. All artwork must be for sale or be available as examples for future commissioned work.
7. An item entered for judging:
 - a. Must be signed or hallmarked. Cast editions, graphics and photographs must also include the edition size and number if applicable.
 - b. Must be for sale and must be priced accordingly.
 - c. Must not be sold before SEASAM; all youth art sales are to be handled by the Chickasaw Nation Arts and Humanities Division.
 - d. Must not have won an award in any prior SEASAM competition.
 - e. Miniatures must be no more than 4.5" tall, wide or deep.
8. Joint or collaborative entries will not be accepted at this competition.
9. SEASAM will not accept items that are not in compliance with the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (<https://www.doi.gov/iacb/act>) or any endangered species regulations (<https://www.fws.gov/endangered/laws-policies>) regardless of permit ownership. Items must comply with federal regulations applicable to SEASAM.
10. In the event of loss or damage, the youth artist will be bound by the release of liability and acknowledgment and acceptance of the dangers, risks and hazards form signed by the youth artist after acceptance to SEASAM.
11. Submitting an item for consideration to the SEASAM judges does not create rights, guarantees or promises that the item will be selected as a winner in any category.
12. The SEASAM committee and/or its judges have the discretion of placing items in different categories or creating a new category if they determine that the item fits the criteria for judging.
13. Judges may also close a category due to the lack of qualified competition or insufficient number of competitors.
14. The youth artist releases and agrees to hold harmless the Chickasaw Nation from any damages to their property or personal injury that they or their helpers may sustain while participating in SEASAM.
15. Nothing contained herein will be construed to waive the sovereign rights and immunities of the Chickasaw Nation, its officers, employees or agents.
